Saturday Dear Father + mother / Jam now at, Room 47, Westham Banh, Weymouth. Jeschert you have heard from auntre about me. I am ait quite habby so there is nothing whatever to Wong over . anested on Wed: + taken to Horfuld Banaches but not allowed ant of yard. met 5 other C.O's there. Four were shifted yester da t a chah, Lewis, + I taken by motor long to Temp the mater ad much to the anusement of all I was hicked up by soldiers + bitched in. all took it in the best of shirts. I eschect to be in the Guardroom in monday + then D.C.M. I hear 4 C.Os are already in the guardroon. We have dadged the senting to-night so have from about 6-30 till 8-30 round the town. Will I have to white again shorth. your affer Ein.
