November 8th 1916

The Guard Room,
Westham Camp,
Weymouth.

Dear Father + Mother

I leave here to-day for
Wormwood Scrubs Prison to serve a sentence
of 112 days. The sentence was read out
to-day. I understand the whole camp
moves on to Portland on Thursday.

Believe G.W.R. Paddington.

Only $\frac{1}{2}$ hour notice. I have let Auntie Clara
+ Miss Tathell know.

communicate my whereabouts.
